Fair in the Square

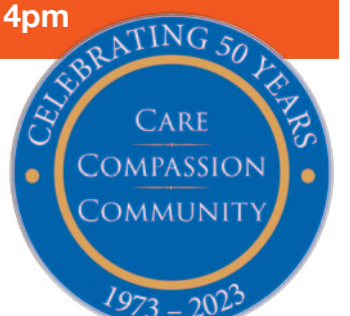
