

NOTICE TO MARINERS

Health & Safety | Dublin Port Pass

Dublin Port Company (DPC) has introduced a new mandatory Health & Safety and Security induction called the Dublin Port Pass, full details are online at: www.dublinport.ie/dublinportpass/



A valid Dublin Port Pass is required by all persons requiring access to the North and South Port Common User Areas, this includes Port Employees, Tenants, Agents, Stevedores, Lines Men, Contractors, Suppliers, Drivers and Visitors. Persons who have not completed a Dublin Port Pass will not be granted entry.

The Dublin Port Pass is currently available in English, Irish, Filipino, Polish, Romanian and Russian.

Dublin Port is committed to Seafarers safety and protecting their rights to shore leave, for Seafarers on vessels that visit Dublin Port they can either complete a Dublin Port Pass or carry a Shore Pass available at: www.dublinport.ie/dublinportpass/seafarers-safety-guide/

A separate safety induction is required for access to the Oil Zone. Persons wishing to access the Oil Zone should contact their agent or the Oil Zone Fire Wardens.

Basic Safety Rules for the Port, Quays and Terminals



Keep 1.5m back from quay wall at all times. Think water safety.



Be aware of lifting operations and moving machinery. Keep well clear.



Hi-visibility clothing must be worn.



Always use walkways provided.



Smoking in designated areas. No littering.



Mobile devices approved usage only.

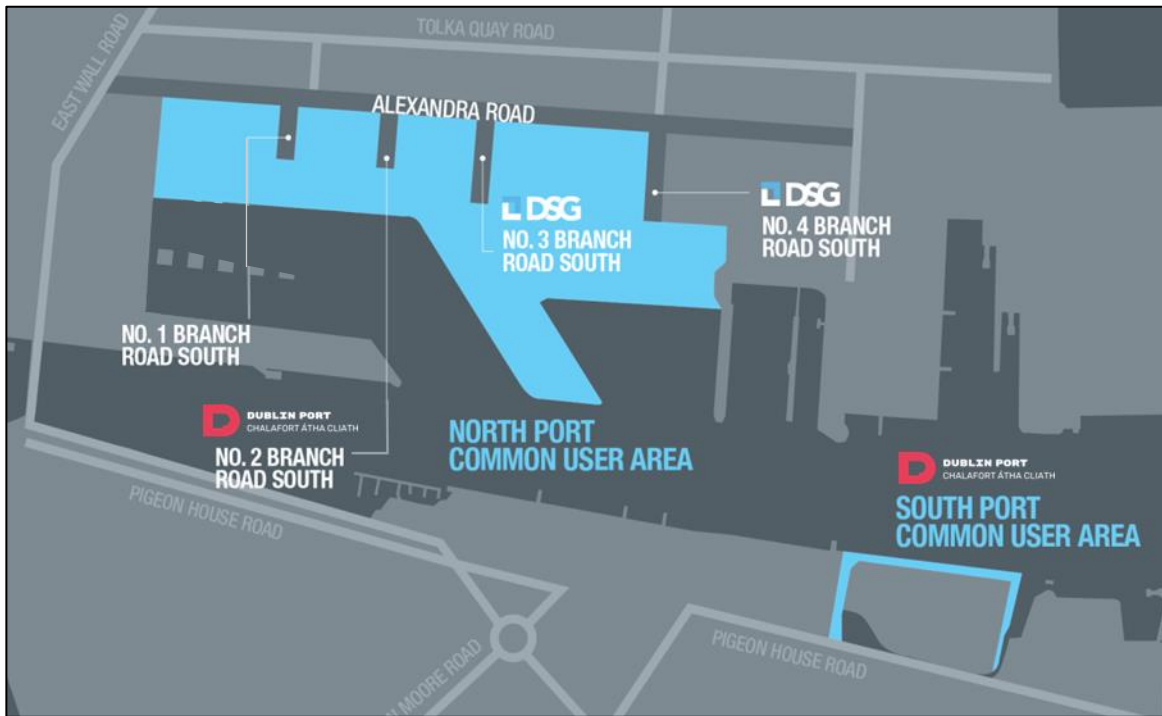
