

# NOTICE TO MARINERS

## Ferry Services | Slot Times

Dublin Port has issued slot times to RO/RO ferry sailings on regular scheduled services. Notwithstanding any requirement of COLREGS or any instruction given by VTS, the term slot time refers to the period of time allocated to enable a vessel to pass unhindered by other shipping traffic through the channel narrows delineated at the eastern end by Buoys No.7 & 8 and at the western end by Buoys No.9 & 10.

Ferry Services are currently operating on modified sailing schedules – Ferry slot times will be published at a later date once regular scheduled sailings have resumed
